

## IB Diploma programme / DP / Grade 11–12

In the DP (Grade 11–12), you study six subjects over two years. Three subjects are studied at higher level (HL), each subject represents 240 teaching hours, and three at standard level (SL), each subject represents 150 teaching hours.

You choose one subject from each of group 1 to 5. The sixth subject may be an arts subject chosen from group 6, or you may choose another subject from groups 1 to 4. In addition to your six DP subjects, you also need to fulfill the three requirements at the Core of the programme: Theory of Knowledge (TOK), Extended Essay (EE), and Creativity, activity, service (CAS).

In the final year of the DP, you sit externally assessed final exams in all six of your subjects.

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### Group 1 - Studies in Language and Literature

- English A Literature (SL & HL)
- English A Language and Literature (SL & HL)
- Swedish A Literature (SL & HL)
- Other Language A Literature (at SL offered as a school supported self-taught language)

### Group 2 - Language Acquisition

- English B (SL & HL)
- Swedish B (SL & HL)
- Swedish ab initio (SL only)
- French B (SL & HL)
- Spanish B (SL & HL)

### The Core

In addition to your six DP subjects, you also need to fulfill the three requirements at the core of the programme:

- Theory of Knowledge (TOK)
- Extended Essay (EE)
- Creativity, activity, service (CAS)

- History (SL & HL)
- Economics (SL & HL)
- Psychology (SL & HL)
- Global Politics (SL & HL)
- Business and Management (SL & HL)

### Group 4 - Sciences

- Biology (SL & HL)
- Chemistry (SL & HL)
- Physics (SL & HL)
- Environmental Systems and Societies (SL only)

### Group 5 - Mathematics

- Mathematics: analysis and approaches HL = Gy11 Matematik 1–5
- Mathematics: analysis and approaches SL = Gy11 Matematik 1–4
- Mathematics: applications and interpretation SL = Gy11 Matematik 1–3

### Group 6 – The Arts

- Visual Arts (SL & HL)
- Or a second subject from Group 1 to 4
